Clean up: 6:30 to 7:00 - 5+ volunteers

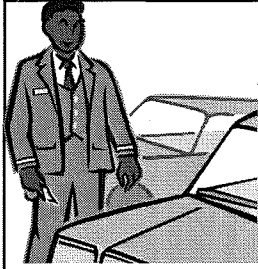

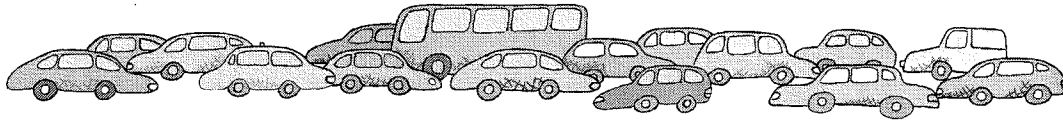
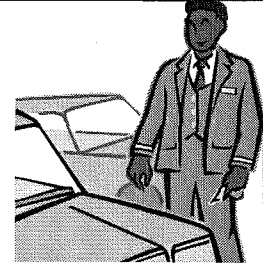
## **RCA'S SYSTEM OF FLIER DELIVERY**
